Official Statutes - World Speed Pitch and Putt Federation (WSPPF)

Article 1 - Name

A non-profit association is established under Catalan/Spanish law named "World Speed Pitch and Putt Federation", abbreviated "WSPPF".

Article 2 - Headquarters

The headquarters is located in Catalonia. It may be relocated by decision of the Executive Committee.

Article 3 - Purpose

The Federation aims to promote, organize, develop, regulate, and represent Speed Pitch and Putt internationally. It organizes competitions, publishes official rankings, coordinates national federations, and issues sports licenses.

Article 4 - Duration

The duration of the association is unlimited.

Article 5 - Members

The association includes:

- Founding members
- Affiliated national federations
- Recognized clubs or leagues
- Licensed players (via annual membership of 30 including insurance and tournament discounts)

Article 6 - Governing Bodies

The governing bodies are:

- The General Assembly (each body representative has one vote)
- The Executive Committee (President, VP, SG, Treasurer, etc.)
- Technical Commissions (sport, technique, refereeing, HCP, development, etc.)

Article 7 - Resources

Resources come from annual fees, grants, donations, competition revenues, and partnerships.

Article 8 - Membership Fees

The annual fee is proposed by the Executive Committee and approved by the General Assembly. Currently set at 30 per player. It entitles:

- An official license
- Insurance
- Access to official competitions
- A dynamic HCP ranking
- Discounts on entry fees

Article 9 - Handicap (HCP)

The HCP is adjusted after each tournament:

- -0.15 point per stroke under the HCP
- +0.05 point per stroke over (max +0.5)
- No minimum limit

The system is valid for 18 holes with a putter and maximum 2 clubs.

Article 10 - Statute Amendments

Statutes may be amended by Extraordinary General Assembly with a 2/3 majority.

Article 11 - Dissolution

In case of dissolution, the net assets will be allocated to another organization with a similar purpose or a charitable cause.
